RESPONDENT CATEGORIES WERE MATCHED TO THE 2016 CURRENT POPULATION SURVEY (CPS) FOR GENDER, AGE, RACE, AND EDUCATION WITH WEIGHTED SELECTION WITHIN STRATA. ALL FIGURES PRESENTED IN THIS DOCUMENT ARE FOR REGISTERED DEMOCRATS OR INDEPENDENTS. RESULTS REFLECT WEIGHTING FOR RACE, GENDER AND AGE.
